## **Directions To Bird Walk Locations**

**North Walnut Grove Trail --Go north on White Chapel in Southlake until the road ends in a gravel parking lot.**

**Quail Creek Trail --Go north on Carroll Avenue in Southlake until it ends at Burney Lane. Turn left on Burney and left onto Harbor Court. The second house on the right is 890 Harbor Court. Just park along the street in front of 890 Harbor Court.**

**Bob Jones Park Trail --Go north on White Chapel until you come to the south entrance of Bob Jones Park (this will be the first entrance with stone markers). Follow the road around until to the parking lot across from the dog park.**

**Bob Jones Nature Center and Preserve--Go north on White Chapel past Bob Jones Park to East Bob Jones Road. Take a right and travel about 1/2 mile to the entrance of the Nature Center and Preserve. The entrance is marked by a stone marker. Follow the road to the parking lot at the Nature Center facility. Please note:**

**If it is raining at the starting time of the hike, the hike will be cancelled. Most of the trails can be muddy after rainy periods. Red muds can stain white sneakers.**

**Most hikes take 2 hours and are of little to moderate difficulty. All hikes are so designed so that people needing to leave early can get back to their cars at approximate half-way points.**

**The Southlake Ornithological Society hikes are designed primarily for adults however the Bob Jones Nature Center provides wonderful trail activities for children's opportunities.**
